### Celebrate and Care:

Have each person share a high and low from this last week.

### Open Up:

### Discuss:

**Choose one or two questions for your group to discuss as time allows.**

- ▶ Identify a few places where individuals are part of something bigger than their role. Talk about what would happen if that part wasn't there?
- ▶ 1 Corinthians 12:7 (MSG) says, "Each person is given something to do that shows who God is." Share what your "something" is and how it shows who God is.
- ▶ How can gathering together help us individually answer the call to be witnesses?

### Engage:

**Spend 1-2 minutes in silence with these questions then share your thoughts.**

Ask God to reveal the "sweet spot" in your calling. What do you need to do to respond well to that revelation?

Who is someone that you need? Is there something you need to say to them?

Who do you need to make yourself available to? Do they know you are there for them?
