Small Group Outline & Discussion Questions

Celebrate and Care:

Have each person share a high and low from this past week.

Big Idea:

Know the secret of Christ in me so that I can share the secret with others.

Open Up:

How do you see things in life?

- The glass is half full
- The glass is half empty
- I've got some questions—is the liquid being poured in or poured out?
- I don't really care how full it is is what's inside it worth drinking?

Discuss:

Choose one or two questions for your group to discuss as time allows.

- Discuss "practice what you preach" vs. "preach what you practice"
- Name some ways life is difficult because of the decision to follow Jesus. Now name some ways it is easier.
- ▶ Read Colossians 2:6-7. Think about the phrase "Christ in me." How does that impact a person's life?

Engage:

Spend 1-2 minutes in silence with these questions then share your thoughts.

How does the idea that your struggle is never just for you alone change how you see your current season?

Read Philippians 1:12-14. Paul was in prison, but didn't see prison as the problem. What is a current situation in your life that could use this perspective shift?

Is there a struggle that you faced where you can now see the treasure that was buried under the dirt and weeds?

- How does this help you in your current season?

Close together in prayer.

As you pray together, remember that God is faithful and will give you what you need in your current season.
